- 1) Abstract should not be more than 150 words, keywords should be atleast 5 words.
- 2) 1.5 spacing with 1-inch margins on all sides on A4 size paper using Times New Roman,12 pt.
- 3) The first page of the manuscript should have the title of the paper, name of the author(s), organization affiliation, mailing address, phone number, e-mail address.
- 4) Abstract should start from second page.
- 5) For full length, Format should be Abstract, Introduction, Statement of problem, Objectives, Methodology, Findings, Implications, Conclusion.
- 6) The participants need to register by paying applicable fee and attaching the payment proof.
- 7) The registration& payment link is being shared in the brochure.
